

Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

The Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead is conducting a review of its polling districts and polling places in accordance with the Polling Districts and Polling Places (Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2006.

The review will consider the suitability of polling places in meeting the needs of electors voting at a polling station, and if appropriate, make recommendations for changes.

The Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead invites residents, interested bodies, local community groups and political groups to make representations on the polling district and polling places scheme which is intended for implementation at the local elections on 2 May 2019. We also welcome views from persons who may have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

Wherever possible persons or organisations making representations to change a polling place should make suggestions as to alternatives.

The review will commence on **1 October 2018** and initial representations and comments should be submitted in writing by **9 November 2018**.

Information regarding the proposed polling district and polling places scheme can be viewed on the council's website at www3.rbwm.gov.uk/elections. Copies of maps depicting polling station locations will be available for inspection at the public libraries in Ascot, Maidenhead and Windsor.
